

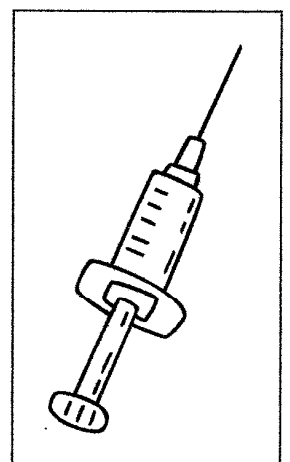
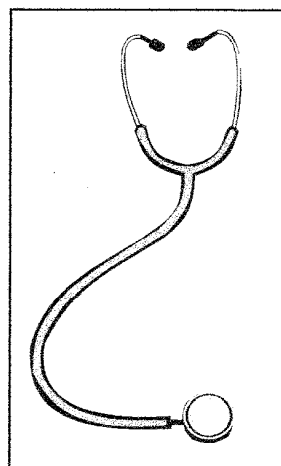
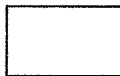
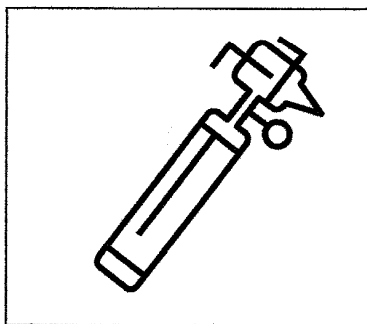
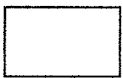
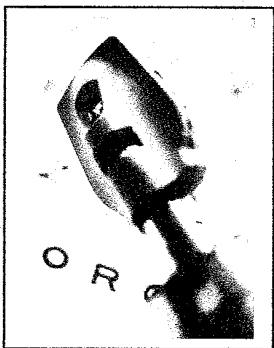
A DAY AT YOUR VETERINARIAN'S OFFICE

A veterinarian is a doctor for animals. A veterinarian specializes in small animals such as dogs and cats or large animals such as cows and horses.

As a responsible owner, you will be taking your pet to see the veterinarian at least once per years for a physical exam and vaccines. Vaccines are necessary to keep your pet safe from certain diseases.

During the physical exam, the veterinarian will:

- Listen to your pet's heart and lungs with a stethoscope.
- Look through an otoscope to check the inside of your pet's ears
- Check your pet's eyes by using an ophthalmoscope
- Once your pet's gets a head to tail check up, vaccines will be given by syringe then a clean bill of health!
